To Community Garden Organizations:

The Pennsylvania Heartland Unit of The Herb Society of America, a group dedicated to studying and actively sharing horticulture history and exploring herb use, is pleased to offer grants to non-profit organizations in the area served by the Heartland Unit, which includes Berks, Montgomery, Chester, York, Schuylkill, Lancaster, Columbia, Lehigh and Lebanon counties.

The following grant eligibility criteria must be met:

1. Grant eligibility requires that the organization requesting a grant must provide a federal EIN to document non-profit status.
2. Projects must be truly herb-related and educational.
3. Financial need must be demonstrated.
4. All grant requests must state specifically how the money is to be used. A detailed budget must be included.
5. Non-profit organizations seeking a donation will be required to submit a request in writing no later than March 1st.
6. Garden projects supported by the Pennsylvania Heartland Herb Society are requested to publicly acknowledge support provided by this organization. (e.g. statements on signage, in promotional materials, handouts and/or online media.)
7. Organizations that did not receive grant funds from our Unit the previous year will be given priority.
